At Wennington Hall School, admissions are linked directly to the process through which an Education Health Care Plan is created. The most important people in this process are the parents and the Special Educational Needs Caseworker.

The School's Admission Panel agrees and confirms admissions on a termly basis. The Panel may consists of: -

- The Special Educational Needs Caseworker
- Educational Psychologist
- SEN and Disability Officer
- Headteacher and or Deputy Headteacher and or Assistant Headteacher and or SENCO
